DOWNLOAD & EXTRACT



After a successful payment download your file(s). Next, extract the compressed .zip file(s).

.ai files

To open and edit .ai Illustrator files containing artboards Adobe Illustrator CS6+ is required. Some effects may require a newer version.

.psd files

To open .psd files Adobe Photoshop CS6+ is needed. Files with this file extension are called Adobe Photoshop document files.

.eps files

To open .eps vector files any program that supports vector files can import the data. However, Adobe Illustrator is also capable of fully editing .eps files.

.svg files

Great for web projects. Scale and transform vector files without quality loss.

.png files

Raster graphics file format that supports lossless data compression. Supports transparent backgrounds, great for web projects.

EDIT & SAVE



Open the .ai files inside Adobe Illustrator and .psd files inside Adobe Photoshop.

Some files may contain groups and separate artboards/layers. To ungroup them press **Shift + Command + G** on a MAC or **Shift + Ctrl + G** on Windows.

To edit text pick the **Type Tool (T)**.

Click and change the text you want. If the original font(s) are not installed on your computer check the last page of this document to download and install the missing fonts on your machine.

In our designs, we include ready to use color combinations in the form of Swatches.

To open the Swatches panel go to **Window > Swatches**.

Our Swatches will let you change colors and find the right pair in seconds.

Our designs come in **CMYK** color mode, **300dpi** resolution and are ready to print.

For the web, change the color mode to RGB and resolution to 72dpi for smaller and more vibrant images.

To save the final work, simply go to **File > Save**. You can also save additional .pdf files for print or web.

Pdf files are also accessible on smartphones and other mobile devices.
